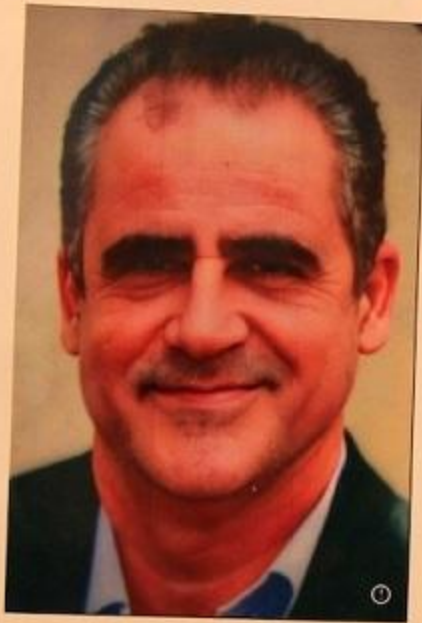


رني شاپان
